HOW TO REGISTER YOUR VESSEL

All new applicants must complete an application form on-line. Current customers should complete an online renewal form. All customers are required to:

- 1) Ensure that the Conservancy receives a copy of a **current and valid insurance certificate** for their vessel.
- 2) Ensure that their **Boat Safety Certificate** is valid if one is required.
- 3) Pay their annual **Licence Fees on or before 01 April 2020**, and ensure the correct amount is paid
- 4) Sign the application form.
- 6) Ensure that their vessel/s are clearly identified with their registration number (unique vessel identification number) clearly visible up to 15 metres either side of their vessel
- 7) For privately owned powered vessels requiring registration after the 1st October, an off peak discount to the annual registration fees may be awarded. Please contact the office directly to discuss eligibility.

Standing Order Arrangement:	10 equal payments starting in April 2019 and ending January 2020, This is only available with the written agreement of the River Manager for Privately owned vessels with an annual fee of £300 or more.	

Please Note: Payment in instalments can only be made in accordance with the Conditions of Registrations. See conditions 6 (b) and (c) in form 20N

Warning:

All vessels on the River in the Cam Conservancy Area must be Registered with the Conservators. Failure to register is a Criminal offence under the Cam Conservancy Byelaws. The Conservators will bring civil proceedings to recover unpaid registration fees together with all costs incurred, including court fees and the fees and costs of debt collection agents employed by them.

VISITING VESSELS

All visiting vessels must have a valid registration for the Cam Conservancy Area (i.e. above Bottisham Lock)

Please Note:

Applications for visitors' licences should be made in advance and completed online via our website.

An annual visitors licence for powered vessels must be purchased and is valid for a period of up to 90 days in the registration year.

All visiting vessels must display clearly their unique vessel registration number. Photographic evidence may be required at the time of registration.

To be eligible to purchase a visitors licence, applicants must be validly registered with another river authority. Evidence may be required before a Visitor Licence is granted. If a vessel does not have a registration with another authority they must purchase a full licence from the Conservancy to enter Conservancy waters.

Environment Agency registered vessels may purchase a Cam Premium at the time of registration with the Environment Agency. If this has not been purchased they must purchase a Visitors' Licence from the Conservancy. These vessels must display clearly their unique vessel registration number, all vessels on the navigation without clear identification will be considered unregistered.
