How to pay

Website

If you register online the application form will automatically calculate your licence fee. You will then be able to pay via PayPal as a guest user using a debit or credit card or using a PayPal account. Payments from Commercial Customers should **not** be made via PayPal.

Instalments

Should you wish to pay by instalment permission must be granted by the CEO prior to 01 April by private and commercial customers for sums over £300, fees totalling less than £300 should be paid in full. Late requests will not be considered for those with historic debts on their account. Contact the Office by email: info@camconservators.org.uk

Private Vessels only:

To pay by instalment you must set up a monthly standing order payment to the Conservators of the River Cam. We will accept 10 equal monthly payments running from April to January.

Commercial Vessels:

To pay by 4 equal instalments, please ensure the payments are made by 01 April 2024, 01 July 2024, 01 October 2024 and 01 January 2025.
